


 Incorporate the positives/successes from the virtual conference to improve the flow and provide more value to the in-person conference:

  - Providing a refreshed, more efficient and safer environment
  - Live streaming select sessions to engage a broader audience and more inclusivity.



#### NEMRA22 – KEY CHANGE

The Group Meetings (MSM's) will be hosted 3 weeks prior on NEMRA provided secure, virtual platform.

- The reason for 3 week prior is to accommodate our members who are attending the Western NAED, which is January 17, 18 and 19.
- We learned from the past conference, being virtual allowed for more participants and better attendance from each organization.
- Having these meetings ahead of the conference should translate into better prepped 1 on 1 meetings and more effective meetings
- Many members have expressed the need and importance of spending more time, and to have more of their team involved, in the very important One on One meetings



#### NEMRA22 – KEY CHANGE

#### One-on-one meetings will be hosted in modular suites, in the Trinity Ballroom, as an alternative to using room suites

- Modular suites can and will be positioned to ensure minimal distractions/noise
- Modular suites can be customized to size as well as how many adjacent units to accommodate simultaneous meetings
- Modular suites usher in a new, upscaled environment that improves upon the traditional pipe/drape meeting space which are undesirable, not private, not comfortable and not secure
- In addition, NEMRA will offer ala Carte options such as:
  - Hotel supplied A/V cables and cords
  - TV's
  - Whiteboard with pens
  - Pre-set breakfast and lunch options



## BENEFITS

Modular Suites

- Modular suites provide a safer meeting environment
  - Consistent and frequent cleaning and sanitizing service of suites throughout the day
- Modular suites bring and keep everyone "together"
  - Encourages and enables networking to occur daily and throughout the conference
  - Minimizes the amount of time to get from one meeting to another
  - Maximizes the time spent in the One-on-One meetings
- Modular suites offer many of the same amenities/services found in a tower suite.
  - Privacy/Security
  - Food/Beverage Service
  - Technology to present/stream meeting materials (if required)
- Modular Suites keep your room "private" and/or eliminates the need to have a separate room.



#### Additional Changes

- Sofas, tables and high tops will be sprinkled in and throughout the Trinity Ballroom that will provide additional spaces for networking and prepping before and after your one-on-one meetings
- Several snack, water, and coffee stations, as we had in Orlando, will be positioned throughout the Trinity Ballroom & Foyer
  - These will be tended by staff personnel to provide white glove service, ensuring we serve our members in the most professional and safest way
- Housekeeping will be positioned throughout the Trinity Ballroom for quick in and out cleanings/refresh of modular suites between each meeting, as well as to keep common seating areas cleaned
  - This is a benefit for bringing the one on one meetings in the modular suites as it will provide better and more frequent service than to tower suite holders



#### Additional Changes

- NEMRA addresses and Keynote Speaker to the front of the conference to ensure maximum participation
- Availability of (6) private rooms on Wednesday and Thursday to hold an onsite reception
  - Many have expressed and/or struggle with getting attendees or the right attendees to dinners. This option will provide them with an alternative as well as additional networking opportunities onsite. In addition to using these as a reception, these can also be used for recognizing top performers, etc.
  - This will provide the opportunity to engage with and treat all of your reps, while still leaving the option to have off-site dinners.

- 3 sessions that promise to deliver impactful, relevant content and insights that will deliver results.
